# **CPC30320 Certificate III in Concreting**

## **Description**

This qualification reflects the role of concreters working in concreting operations on residential and commercial projects.

Occupational titles may include:

- ✓ Concreter
- ✓ Concrete tilt panel fabricator

The qualification has core unit of competency requirements that cover common skills for the construction industry, as well as a specialised field of work.

The construction industry strongly affirms that training and assessment leading to recognition of skills must be undertaken in a real or very closely simulated workplace environment and this qualification requires all units of competency to be delivered in this context.

Completion of the general induction training program specified by the National Code of Practice for Induction Training for Construction Work (ASCC 2007) and as per Work Health and Safety Regulation 2011 - Part 6.5 General construction induction training is required before entering a construction work site. Achievement of unit CPCCWHS1001/CPCWHS1001 meets this requirement.

### **Packaging Rules**

To achieve this qualification, the candidate must demonstrate competency in:

22 units of competency:

- 17 core units
- 5 elective units.

Some units in this qualification may have prerequisite requirements, which must be met when packaging the qualification. Users are referred to the list of CPC units with prerequisite unit requirements available in this Training Package for this purpose.

## **Enrolment Options**

We currently offer this qualification as:

- A Traineeship over 24 months or
- RPL assessment only with a maximum duration of 3 months.
